- **Disaster Relief**—According to news reports, almost the entire city of Lahaina, Hawaii, on the island of Maui, was destroyed by fire. To date, the death toll is 96, and is likely to exceed 100 as search teams continue their grim work. The Global Methodist Church is working with ministry partners to assist people who lost their homes and nearly all their earthly possessions. - **A New (Old) Kind of Meeting**—As part of our new expression of Methodism with the Global Methodist Church, we will be reclaiming the Wesleyan tradition of Class Meetings. Class Meetings are a small group gathering where we check in with one another on the state of our souls in order that we might be continually transformed and thrive in our discipleship journey. These meetings do not follow a published curriculum; rather, the participants' lives are the curriculum. We will begin with an 8- to 10-week discussion of the book by Kevin M. Watson, [The Class Meeting: Reclaiming a Forgotten \(and Essential\) Small Group Experience](#). Upon completion of the book, different opportunities will be explored to continue meeting weekly to discuss our faith and discipleship. John Wesley believed Class Meetings were so important that it was a requirement for Methodist membership. We believe that reconnecting with this powerful practice will prove successful in growing our faith and our witness as we begin this new leg of our journey together. Classes will begin September 5 and 6, 2023. Available class times are Tuesdays at 1:00 pm in the Fellowship Hall with Kathy Heimel, and Wednesdays at 6:00 pm in the Celebration Sunday School room (FLC) with Susan Maddux. There will be sign-up sheets in the FLC and in the side hallway of the church, or you can call the office to sign up.
- **GMC Catechism/Bible Study**—As part of our new expression of Methodism with the Global Methodist Church, we will begin a study of the Catechism of Christian Faith and Doctrine for the Global Methodist Church. This study is recommended for all who are initiated into the church. As we are all new members of the GMC, this study is for everyone. Each participant will receive a booklet containing the catechism, and we will use this and the Bible as the curriculum. Classes will begin September 10 at 6:00 pm in the Fellowship Hall, no sign-up needed.

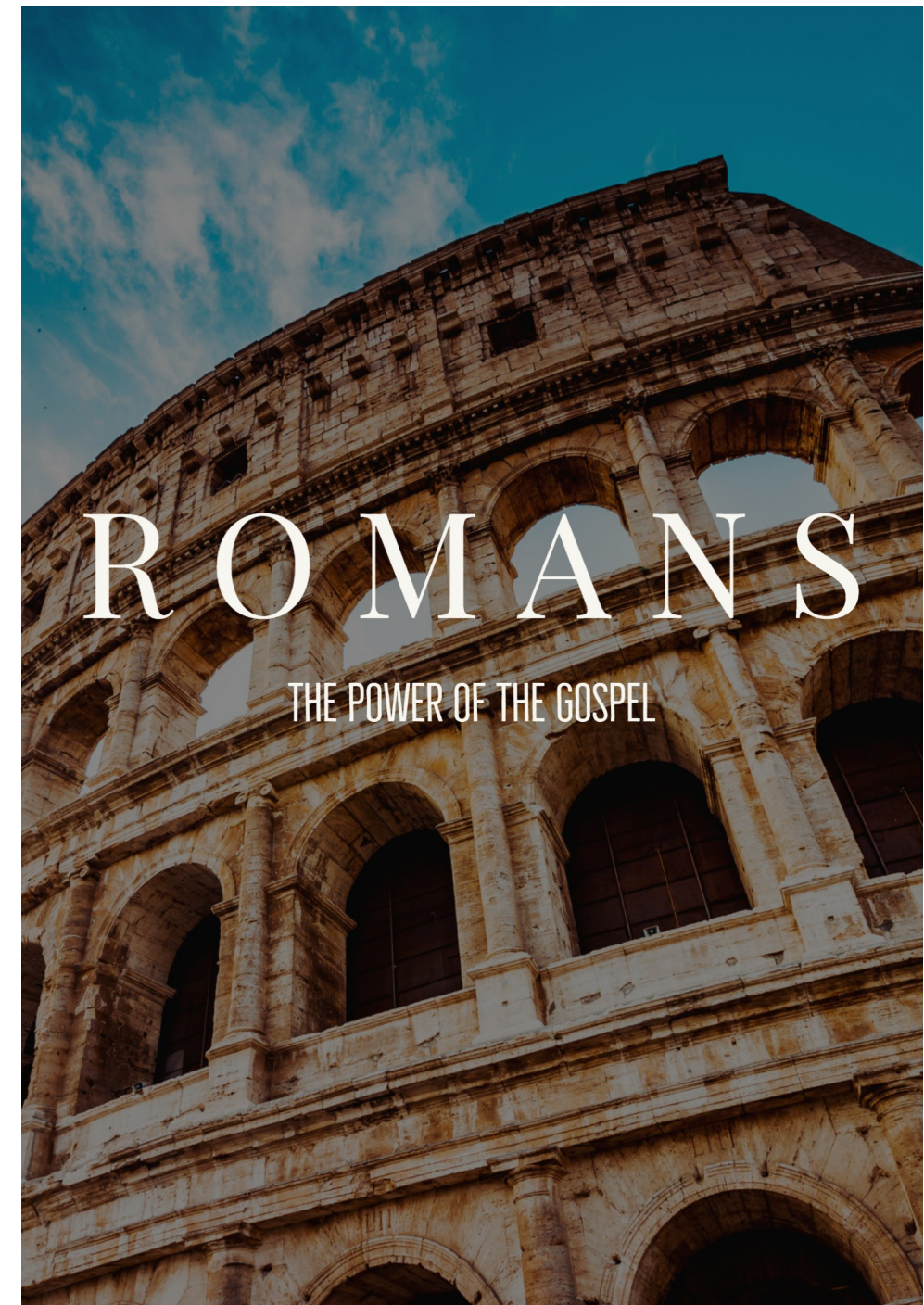
Would you like to support ministries of SCM through giving? There are three ways you can give:
