Zephaniah 3:14-20

¹⁴ Sing aloud, O daughter of Zion; shout, O Israel! Rejoice and exult with all your heart, O daughter of Jerusalem! ¹⁵ The LORD has taken away the judgments against you; he has cleared away your enemies. The King of Israel, the LORD, is in your midst; you shall never again fear evil. ¹⁶ On that day it shall be said to Jerusalem: "Fear not, O Zion: let not your hands grow weak. ¹⁷ The LORD your God is in your midst, a mighty one who will save; he will rejoice over you with gladness; he will quiet you by his love; he will exult over you with loud singing. ¹⁸ I will gather those of you who mourn for the festival, so that you will no longer suffer reproach. ¹⁹ Behold, at that time I will deal with all your oppressors. And I will save the lame and gather the outcast, and I will change their shame into praise and renown in all the earth. ²⁰ At that time I will bring you in, at the time when I gather you together; for I will make you renowned and praised among all the peoples of the earth, when I restore your fortunes before your eyes," says the LORD.

I have been called a scrooge at times, I suppose partly because I don't like putting up Christmas decorations by November 1. But really, nothing could be further from the truth, especially when it comes to music. In my younger days I was a Spinning® instructor at the local YMCA, and every December my classes would compete in what I called the "Kris Kringle Klassic," a pretend bicycle stage race as we worked out all month to upbeat Christmas music. I often have wondered why we have so much wonderful Christmas hymns and not nearly as many Easter hymns. Yet, I take joy in the Christmas hymns as much as possible.

The prophet Zephaniah tells us that God will announce that he is living among us as a mighty savior who delights over us with gladness. That is the announcement of Christmas. Along with this announcement of Immanuel— God with us—we are told that God will rejoice over us with joyful songs. When I think of God delighting over me to the point of singing joyful songs, it makes me feel special. Indeed, I am special and so are you. That is why God came and dwelt among us. And as God sings over us, I suppose that is why we sing back to God with the joy that God has given to us.

I hope during this season of preparation that we can all experience the joy God has over us that prompted the Bethlehem birth. I also hope that as we live in expectation of his return that we can live as people who have a joyful song in our hearts because He is still Immanuel—God with us—through His Holy Spirit.
