A Note from Pastor Dave...

Lent begins with Ash Wednesday which this year is on February 14. Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent, the 40 days of fasting and penance that culminate in Easter Sunday. In AD 325 at the Council of Nicaea, the Church agreed that Easter should be celebrated on the Sunday following the first full moon after the vernal equinox, which means Easter in the Western Church can occur anytime between March 22 and April 25. The Council of Nicaea also settled on a 40-day fast period for Lent because 40 has biblical roots in the story of Noah (Genesis 7:4), Moses (Exodus 24:18), Elijah (1 Kings 19:8), and most importantly Jesus (Matthew 4:1-11). It wasn't until AD 601 that Pope Gregory moved the start of Lent to 46 days before Easter and establish Ash Wednesday as the start date. This allowed for 40 days of fasting with the six Sundays counted as feast days. Ashes are also a biblical symbol of repentance in the stories of Mordecai (Esther 4:1), Job (Job 42:6), and the City of Nineveh in Jonah. Today we impose ashes to remember our own mortality ("Remember that thou art dust and to dust thou shalt return") and to repent of our Sin ("Repent and believe in the Gospel").

For our Ash Wednesday observance we will have a short (30 minute) prayer time and imposition of ashes at two times: 11:30 a.m. in the sanctuary and 5:30 p.m. in the family life center. I hope to see you on Ash Wednesday.

During the season of Lent, I will be preaching a Lenten sermon series called "Altar'd". Lent is the time in which we prepare to encounter the cross. As the Jews presented sacrifices on an altar for the atonement of sin, God offers on our behalf the ultimate sacrifice for all Sin on the altar of the cross. So Lent is a time of altars, but it is also a time to be altered by God. We seek transformation, to be changed when we encounter Christ, to be altered as we move on to sanctification. This sermon series will be about being altered at the altar.

As we are altered by the grace of Christ throughout the fast of Lent, we are prepared to celebrate the feast of Easter. Join us at 7:00 a.m. at Veteran's Park for Easter Sunrise worship followed by breakfast in the Family Life Center.

February's First Dollar Sunday will go to Souper Bowl Sunday. To support this ministry opportunity, leave a dollar on your seat as you leave service on February 4.


SCM Kids
