Running the Race June 2024

Several years ago in October, I went with a couple of friends backpacking at Canyonlands National Park in Utah. We hiked in Elephant Canyon in the Needles District. The trail was all rock. And all sun. It was hot. We have to follow the trail by following cairns on the rock (small stacks of rocks as trail markers). Once we descended down into the canyon, we found ourselves on a small stream where we rehydrated and refilled our water bottles. We climbed out of the canyon to camp and set up camp with an overlook that was amazing. After supper we hiked back down to our watering hole, but the stream had dried up. We could not pump enough water out with our filter pump. We ended up on a plateau above our campsite where there were some depressions in the rock still containing water from the last rain. We pumped enough out of those holes to do us for the night.

After dark we looked out over the dark canyon and kept seeing lights in the sky. In the middle of the night we knew those lights were lightening. And my friend's tent was strategically placed just below a new waterfall. We quickly got his tent moved and his sleeping bag into my tent and pots under the new flow of water so we could drink it the next morning (filtered of course).

The Holy Spirit is like that rain. Sometimes we feel just a dribble, and other times He pours out on us. But He always seems to be enough. And He always seems to be at the right time. Sometimes we pray and fast seeking a move of the Holy Spirit, and sometimes He just comes as He will unexpectedly. One thing I've learned with camping and rain is to always expect the unexpected. Likewise with the Holy Spirit, we should always expect the unexpected. I suspect that the disciples gathered on Pentecost did not expect what they received. And they could never have known how the Spirit would use them in the coming months and years in unexpected ways. The important thing is for us to respond to the Spirit's presence in whatever way He moves.
