I without hesitation dialed Tom to get details, and as the call was being connected, I received a text from Tom asking me to call him. So instead of "Hello" I received "Well, that was fast." I asked what he needed and he told me that he wanted to see if Spring City would host Rev. Zaqueu Ranchase, the Conference Superintendent of Mozambique on the Sunday before annual conference begins. I responded that I was calling to see if we could get Rev. Ranchase to come speak on the Sunday before annual conference begins. This seemed to be one of the sets of circumstances when the Holy Spirit must be saying, "You need to do this."

So, on Sunday, June 8, Rev. Zaqueu Ranchase, Conference Superintendent of Mozambique Annual Conference will be with us to share about his ministry, Mozambique and the Global Methodist Church, Mozambique's partnership with the MidSouth Annual Conference, and to give us a word from God. This is an exciting opportunity and I hope you will show your support for our connectional ministry and give both Rev. Wilson and Rev. Ranchase a warm and celebratory East Tennessee welcome.
